



Call for Papers: Haskins Sponsored Session at Kalamazoo 2017

The Haskins Society invites proposals for its sponsored sessions for the International Medieval Congress at Kalamazoo held 11–14 May 2017.

We welcome proposals for complete sessions (three papers on a shared theme or problem) and for individual papers. In particular, we welcome proposals for **“New Voices in Medieval History”** which will feature papers by early career scholars (graduate students, untenured faculty, and independent scholars) who are eligible for the Denis Bethell Prize.

How to submit: For individual papers, please send a 250 word abstract, CV, and Participant Information Form (on the [Congress website](#)). For panel proposals, please send abstracts, CVs, and PIFs for all panelists and a brief description of the panel’s theme. Proposals should be sent to Prof. Robert Berkhofer at robert.berkhofer@wmich.edu. Proposals may be sent immediately and no later than Monday, September 12, 2016.
